

Walking Information

We welcome all to the Castlegregory Walking Festival, whether you are a seasoned walker or just beginning. You do not need to belong to a walking club to take part! Children under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

It is important that you choose the walk most suited to your level of fitness and experience. If you decide to undertake one of the high mountain walks and you are not fit enough to do so you may risk not only your own safety but that of fellow walkers and those who may have to rescue you.

Dogs are not permitted.

Protective Clothing

Walkers on the Mountain routes should carry the following:

- rucksack
- walking boots are strongly recommended for all difficult and moderate walks.
- waterproof coat and leggings
- spare clothing
- hat and gloves
- snacks.
- at least one litre of water.

FOR SAFETY REASONS PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOU CHECK IN WITH THE WALK LEADER AT THE END OF YOUR WALK.

Transport

Transport is provided to the start and from the end of each walk except for the easy walk on Saturday. Start times: Difficult 9am Moderate 9.30am Easy 10am
