**Coumbowler Loop Walk** is an easy 2 hr low-level route from Dingle town, 10 km with a height gain of less than 100m, taking in some of the Dingle Way on the way out and a minor road past Garfinny bridge on way back. **€10 cover charge.**

## Saturday 19th September

Registration

8:30 – 9:30

**A) Baile na hAbha-Mt Brandon-Conor Pass-Dingle** is a **very strenuous** but spectacular walk of at least 7 hrs duration, 25km, with a number of peaks and troughs, Mt Brandon 954m, an GEARÁN 840m, Cnoc Bhaile Uí Shé 623m, suitable only for the experienced fit hillwalker. **€20 cover charge.**

9:30 – 10:00

**B) Goulin Hill** is a moderate walk of 3 hours, 8 km, height 649m **or an extension of this** to Com an Áir Lakes+ Sliabh Mhaca Ré which is a more strenuous walk of 5 hrs, 15 km. **€20 cover charge.**

10.30 – 11.00

**C) A Bus Tour and Walk** taking in the Sleá Head Route of The Dingle Peninsula and visiting the ancient archeological and monastic sites of the area. **Limited to 16 persons. €20 cover charge.**

**D) A Biodiversity walk** of 2 to 3 hours close to Dingle. **€10 cover charge.**

09:30 – 10:30	A) <b>Fán-Mt Eagle-Dún Chaoin</b> is a moderate grade for a regular hillwalker of 4 hours duration, 10 km and height of 516m. This route has spectacular views. <b>€20 cover charge.</b>
10:00 – 10:30	B) <b>Fán-Dingle Way-Coumeenole-Dún Chaoin</b> is <b>an easier walk</b> than (A), covering the first part of it but shortening it to 7Km and high point is 300m. <b>Cover charge €20.</b>
10:00 – 11:30	C) <b>Dingle Historical Town Walk</b> roughly 1.5 – 2 hours. <b>€10 cover charge.</b>
10:00 – 10:30	D) <b>A Mindfulness Walk</b> of 2 to 3 hours close to Dingle. €10 cover charge.
